Item 2. Engine Number	Inspected	Corrected
 Check engine number which will appear on the main engine component of the vehicle against the prepared documentation. Engine No 		
Item 3. VIN		Corrected
Check the VIN of the vehicle against the documentation and the compliance plate. VIN		
Item 4. Compliance As per the Consumer Goods (Quad Bikes) Safety Standard 2019 following items need to be check and inspected.	Inspected	Corrected

Lateral roll stability Swing Tag		
Compliance with the US Standard sticker		
Item 5. Riding controls	Inspected	Corrected
• Sit on the rider's seat and test all the riding controls.		
• Check the operation of the parking brake. On Australian Design Rule 33 cycles fitted with side-car outfits, check by putting the transmission in neutral, applying parking brake and attempting to move the outfit. The brake must be able to stop the outfit being moved.		
Ensure the horn works.		
• Throttle cable free play. Turn handle bar lock to lock and make sure throttle cable is free and engine revs do not change. Adjust routing and free play if necessary.		
Item 6. Rider's vision	Inspected	Corrected
Check that mirrors are securely attached and forward vision through windscreen (if fitted).		
Item 7. Lights	Inspected	Corrected
 Test the operation of all lights and check the aim of the headlight/s. 		
 Ensure that all compulsory reflectors are not damaged and are fitted to the rear of the vehicle. 		
• Check the number plate light is directing light on to the surface of the number plate and not the rear of the vehicle.		
Item 8. Chassis	Inspected	Corrected
 Check the chassis, sub-frames, transmission, chain guards, exhaust and braking system components. 		

Item 8a. Chassis ATV / UTV and side by side vehicles	Inspected	Corrected
Check Split pin Tie Rod		
Check Split Pin (King pin).		
Check split pin base of steering column.		
Check any remaining split pins to make sure they are fitted correctly.		
• Check tie rod bolts to make sure they are tight. Thread lock recommended.		
 Use a paint marker to put a mark on each split pin and bolt to allow visibility when checking over. 		
Remove wheels check axle crown nuts tension and mark split with paint marker.		
Item 9. Brakes		Corrected
Check the operation of the brake controls.		
• Ensure that where brakes are firmly applied, more than 20% of the pedal or handle travel remains.		
Check that the wheel brake is functioning.		
Inspect visible brake components for leakage and security of mountings.		
Check the effective operation of the park brake.		
Item 10. Wheels and tyres (inspect each road wheel to ensure that:)	Inspected	Corrected
 No wheel or rim is cracked or has pieces of a casting missing, or is buckled. 		
There are no missing or broken wheel mounting nuts, studs or bolts.		
 Any spoked wheel has no missing, loose, broken or cracked spokes. 		
• The tyre or rim does not foul any component at any point over its full range of travel.		
Item 11. Check the suspension, wheel bearings and steering components	Inspected	Corrected
Visually inspect all steering components.		
 Where steering linkages are fitted, the rotational free play must not exceed 10 mm measured at the end of the handlebars. 		
 Check if any nut, bolt or locking device is missing or insecure. 		
• Visually inspect the suspension to ensure no component is broken, cracked, cut, missing or not secured.		
Check that no shock absorber is inoperative or not securely mounted, or that any nut, bolt, or locking device is missing or not secured.		
Item 12. Conditional registration schemes	Inspected	Corrected
All Crossfire Motorcycles vehicles are for Off Road Use only.		
• Laws that govern conditional registration vary state to state. Its vital to contact the local transportation body in the local state to attain list of requirements to be eligible for the scheme. This may include but not limited to number plates, additional insurance and safety beacons. Inspected corrected		
 Ensure one number plate is affixed to the vehicle's rear.
